- 1. (a) Discuss banana cultivation under the following headings:

 - ii) Fertilization (5 marks)
 - iii) Control of stem borer and leaf spot (5 marks)
 - (b) Discuss two measures a farmer may use to enhance the quality of bananas. 10 marks)
- 2. Write short notes on the following:
 - i) Pruning (5 marks)
 - ii) Thinning out (5 marks)
 - iii) Crop rotation (5 marks)
 - iv) Transportation (5 marks)
 - v) Mulching (5 marks)
- 3. Discuss either pineapple or passion fruit production beginning with its family and scientific nature, and stating the ecological requirement and agronomic practices necessary for its successful establishment. (25 marks)
- 4. Soils tend to loose their fertility after a period of continuous cropping:
 - a) Discuss briefly three ways a soil may loose its fertility and three ways it may regain it. (20 marks)
 - b) Discuss two factors that could influence the spacing of a crop. (5 marks)
- 5. a) What do you understand by the term post harvest technology? (5 marks)
 - b) Discuss briefly the post harvest handling of one of the following
 - i) mango
 - ii) pineapple
 - iii) avocado (10 marks)
 - c) Pests and diseases are the most common causes of post harvest losses. In general terms discuss the ways in which you would address this problem. (10 marks)
