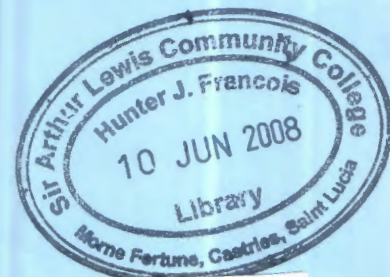

(c) Discuss **two** benefits of organic farming. (5)
3. (a) List **three** environmental factors that affect crop production and explain how each factor affects production. (10)
(b) Why is choosing resistant or tolerant cultivars the cheapest easiest and most effective way to reduce losses due to pest and disease. (10)
(c) Define the term **WEED**. How can weeds reduce the growth and yield of a crop? (10)
4. (a) Define the term irrigation and list common methods of irrigation used. (5)
(b) Explain what is meant by critical period with regards to crop water use and give the critical period for **three** named crops. (10)
(c) Discuss **three** methods of measuring soil moisture. (10)
5. (a) Define the term **soil fertility** and explain three ways a soil may gain fertility and **three** ways it may lose its fertility. (10)
(b) Discuss **three** ways how acid soils may affect crop growth and production. (10)
(c) Explain how chemical (inorganic) fertilizer can be harmful to the environment? (5)
6. (a) Define the term harvest (crop) and explain when and how it may be done. (10)
(b) Post harvest handling of produce is important to maintaining quality. Explain **three** ways this can be achieved. (10)
(d) List **three** components of good storage. (5)
